2016 Boys JSYLL League Rules

Only head coaches can address officials. With the exception of the grade 3/4, all coaches must stay in the coach's box.

Each home field will be required to have a list of rules at the scoring table.

Each week, home field coordinators are required to email the league coordinator with gameday results from all 3 levels. Scores are not required, only winning and losing teams need to be noted.

Prior to the first week of games, each program will be required to submit a roster for each grade level and team.

Grades 3/4, 5/6, and 7/8.....No timeout in the last 5 minutes of the second half.

Eye Black—Solid Stroke Only.

Game balls must be NOSCAE approved balls

Illegal body checks, blindside hits, buddy pass hit, will result in a 2-3 minute non-releasable penalty. Excessive, violent and/or intentional hit is an automatic ejection.

Hits to the head or neck will result in 2-3 minute penalties.

Ejection for fighting will result in a two game suspension.

No one-handed stick checks at any level. It will be called as a slashing penalty.

Grade 3/4, 5/6, and 7/8 will have a four goal free clear option.

Grades 3/4, 5/6, and 7/8 will have a 10 goal mercy rule. Play will continue. The leading team will not attempt to score. Officials have no responsibility on this ruling, other than the game will continue.

Grade 3/4 will have a horn at end line, side line, and any stoppage.

Grade 5/6 will have only a side line horn.

Grades 3/4 and 5/6 will play 25 minute running halves.

Grade 3/4no long poles.

Grade 3/4 will a generous 4 second goalie count, no other counts.

Grade 3/4 and 5/6 will have a free clear on a non-flag offsides.

Grade 7/8 will follow the high school non-flag offsides.

Grade 7/8 will do the mid-field pregame line up

Grade 7/8 will play 12 minute running quarters, one minute between periods, and a three minute half time.

Grade 7/8.....the clock will run during any timeout. When the clock hits the five minute mark, the timeout is immediately over.

Grade 7/8 will play all high school counts, including the two minute 'keep it in'.

Face-offs - Grade 7/8 will follow the high school rule. No tape on the shaft to the crosse. Violation is that the face-off player must leave the field and a substitute must enter. Officials will start a 20 second. Violation is delay of game, no face off. Give the ball to the opponent.
